Kansas Vehicle Registrations

CEDBR recently attained vehicle registration data from the Kansas Department of Revenue, Division of Vehicles. The information is provided by county for 2010. The data is broken out by auto, truck, trailer, motorcycle, motorized bike, RV and special registrations.

The average number of vehicles per capita in Kansas, for the population 16 years and over, in 2010 was 0.91. Wallace County, in the rural portion of the state, had the highest per capita registrations at 4.73 vehicles per person 16 years and over. Douglas County, with a high transient population, had the fewest per capita registrations at 0.87. On average, counties in Kansas had approximately 2.27 vehicle registries per person 16 years and over.
