


WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

April 2014



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index is down 0.6 percent from the January level, and current economic activity is 0.5 percent lower than it was in February of 2013. The current decrease in economic activity can be attributed to the deterioration in three of the four index components. Total non-farm employment has decreased 0.6 percent, unemployment was up 0.4 percent, and the earnings of production employees have decreased 1.9 percent. The deterioration in those index components was partially offset by an improvement in the hours of production employees.

WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity

The leading index continues to predict a small improvement in economic activity through the summer. However, the predicted improvement is smaller in February than it was in January. This is primarily attributed to a significant decline in the Kansas leading index. The Aircraft Production Index and National Industrial Production Index indicate slight improvements. The International Leading Index was stable between January and February.
