


WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

May 2014



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index was flat between February and March, indicating no change in the level of economic activity. The current level of economic activity is estimated to be 0.2 percent lower than it was in March 2013. The improvement in the unemployment rate was offset by the decrease in the weekly earnings of production employees.

WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity

The leading index continues to predict small improvements in economic activity through the early fall. However, the predicted improvement is somewhat higher in March than it was in February. This is primarily attributed to improvements in the Aircraft Production Index and the National Industrial Production Index.
