


WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

February 2015



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index deteriorated slightly between November and December, reversing the November improvement. This decline brought the current level of economic activity slightly below the December 2013 level. The decline can be attributed to a small decrease in the number of workers and a more significant decrease in earnings.

WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity

The leading index indicates there will be a slight decrease in economic activity in the early summer. This will potentially bring economic activity below the 2014 level. The decrease in the leading index can be attributed to a significant deterioration in the Kansas Leading Index.
