


# **WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices**

# **April 2016**



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

#### **WSU Current Index of Economic Activity**

The current index improved between January and February, after declining at the end of the year. The current level of economic activity remains somewhat above the 2015 level. There were improvements in three of the four index components, between January and February. Only the unemployment rate deteriorated, increasing by 0.2 percent between January and February.

## **WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity**

The leading index increased between January and February. However, there continues to be an indication of decreased economic activity through the summer months. There were strong improvements in the Aircraft Production Index and the Kansas Leading Index. However, these improvements were offset by declines in the National Industrial Production Index and the International Leading Index.
