

Unemployment Rate - Atchison County, KS - Civilian Labor Force (not seasonally adjusted)






### **Seasonally Adjusted Retail Sales**

• The CEDBR County Economic Conditions Index is based on employment, retail sales, average wages, and the unemployment rate.






### **Business Dynamism Index**



### Kansas Business Dynamism Index, 2021















## Labor Churn


