

Unemployment Rate - Ellis County, KS - Civilian Labor Force (not seasonally adjusted)






## **Seasonally Adjusted Retail Sales**

• The CEDBR County Economic Conditions Index is based on employment, retail sales, average wages, and the unemployment rate.





### Kansas Business Dynamism Index, 2021




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


