

unemployment rate - Montgomery County, KS - civilian Labor Force (not seasonally adjusted)







Seasonally Adjusted Retail Sales




 The CEDBR County Economic Conditions Index is based on employment, retail sales, average wages, and the unemployment rate.





Business Dynamism Index


• The index measures the dynamism of the business environment in three areas: industry diversification, business expansion, and labor churn.







Kansas Business Dynamism Index, 2021










 Montgomery County ranked 90th highest overall in the state for business expansion.










Montgomery County ranked 26th highest overall in the state.










Montgomery County ranked 8th highest overall in the state.




